

## **BERKSHIRE DOWNS AND CHILTERN GOLDEN RETRIEVER CLUB**

*All trials will be held in accordance with Kennel Club Field Trial Rules and Regulations and those of the Club.*

The Society cannot accept liability for injury, loss, or damage to persons, dogs or property however caused.

Should circumstances so dictate, the Society, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be notified to the Kennel Club at the earliest opportunity.

No modification will be made to the schedule except by permission of the Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals, if time permits, before the closing date of entries

### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

Entries will be accepted by e-mail, providing a cheque is received prior to the commencement of the trial. Entries will NOT be taken over the telephone.

Competitors are reminded of the importance of accuracy on entry forms, all illegible entry forms will be returned for clarification.

The Society reserves the right to refuse any entry for a trial without giving a reason.

More than one place can be applied for but second applications will not be balloted until first applications have been balloted. Names should be entered in order of choice.

Preference in the draw will be given to members of this Society.

The OWNERS including all JOINT OWNERS of dogs entered must be members of this Society to get preference. Joint ownership shall be considered the same as single membership.

Applicants who do not provide an e-mail address or enclose an SAE will NOT be sent of notification of the result.

Substitution of entries will be allowed.

Anyone cancelling within seven days of a trial being run will forfeit the whole entry fee. If a dog is withdrawn owing to injury, sickness or a bitch in season a Veterinary Certificate may be asked for. Any other reason will be at the discretion of the Society's Officers. Dogs which qualify out of Novice Stakes will have their entry fee refunded in full.

Anyone who has been offered a run and who wishes to withdraw must notify the Field Trial Secretary AT ONCE by telephone and not by letter. If leaving a message on the answering machine, full details of person, dog and telephone number and reason for withdrawal must be given clearly.

Entrants must be present by the time the Chief Steward announces that the Trial has begun at which point a reserve dog will take the place of any absentee.

Bitches in season must not be brought to the ground.

All dogs must be kept on a lead except when in line.

Cheques to be made payable to 'The Berkshire Downs & Chilterns Golden Retriever Club'.

A SEPARATE cheque is required for each entry, plus a SAE for result of draw, or preferably provide an e-mail address.
